4. **Purpose**

The aim of the program is to ensure the introduction of a professional program that provides a competitive staff for the field of freight logistics who knows how to fill in transport, warehousing documentation; Storage of cargo in the warehouse; Balance control; Freight planning; Description of the types of transport and selection of the appropriate type of transport; team work; Monitoring and evaluation; Ordering; Cargo loading / unloading supervision; Shipping monitoring.

The goal of the program is to train highly qualified specialists who will perform their duties in compliance with the norms of professional ethics, labor and safety. In addition, specialists will be equipped with professional and general/ transfer skills.

6. **Employment opportunities:** The holder of a professional qualification in logistics in the field of freight logistics can be employed in freight forwarding and transport-logistics organizations; In customs-transport service enterprises; In transport-logistics associations; In transport and expedition organizations; In trade-logistics complexes of different levels; In trade-purchasing and intermediary organizations; In large distributors of finished products; In distribution and logistics centers; In custom terminal complexes; In warehouses, in customs warehouses.

7. **Structure**

Intermediate Professional Qualifications in Logistics - includes 5 general modules with a total of 15 credits and 11 professional modules with a total of 54 credits.

To be awarded a secondary professional qualification in logistics, a person must accumulate 69 credits.

- Volume of the program for Georgian language students - 69 credits;
- Duration of the program for Georgian language students - 46 weeks;
- Program capacity for non-Georgian language students - 99 credits;
- Duration of the program for non-Georgian students - 68 weeks.
