1. Title of Vocational Education Program - Construction of Transport Infrastructure

2. Registration number - 07318-p

3. Qualification to be awarded - Basic Vocational Qualification in Road Construction (Qualification Code 0732)

4. Purpose

The aim of the basic vocational education program is to provide the transport infrastructure sector with competent personnel capable of building, servicing, maintaining, repairing, reconstructing, rehabilitating and monitoring the existing railway infrastructure.

5. Admission criteria

- Basic education,
- Minimum age 18 years

6. Field of employment and opportunities

After completing the basic professional program "Railway Construction", a person can be employed in the private and public sectors, whose activities will be related to the construction, reconstruction and operation of railways.

7. Structure

The educational program includes 5 general modules with a total amount of 14 credits; 5 common professional modules with a total amount of 18 credits; In the direction of elective concentration of railway track construction - 9 specialization modules with a total amount of 47 credits; Also, elective modules are provided for railway track monitoring in the amount of 16 credits.

To qualify, a person must accumulate at least 95 credits, the duration of training is 22 months.

- Volume of the program for Georgian language students - 95 credits;
- Duration of the program for Georgian language students - 78 weeks;
- Volume of the program for non-Georgian students - 110 credits;
- Duration of the program for non-Georgian students - 88 weeks.
