Signalization, Centralization and Blocking on Railway Transport

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1. Title of Vocational Education Program - Railway Operation

2. Registration number - 07118-p

3. Qualification to be awarded - Secondary Vocational Qualification in Railway Operation (Qualification Code 1041)

4. Purpose

The aim of the vocational education program is to train specialists in signaling, centralization and blocking of railway transport in accordance with the requirements of the railway industry.

5. Admission criteria

Complete general education.

6. Field of employment and opportunities

After passing the secondary vocational education program "Railway Transport Alarm, Centralization and Blocking" a person can be employed as a specialist in alarm, centralization and blocking in railway operating organizations.

7. Structure

The educational program includes 5 general modules with a total amount of 15 credits; 8 common professional modules with a total amount of 25 credits; Sectoral direction - 6 specialization modules with a total amount of 50 credits;

To be qualified, a person must accumulate at least 90 credits, the duration of training is 20 months.

- Volume of the program for Georgian language students 90 credits;
- Duration of the program for Georgian language students 80 weeks;
- Program size for non-Georgian language students 120 credits;
- Duration of the program for non-Georgian students 100 weeks.
